16. To what extent did the party leadership take responsibility, or encourage, SA street fighting in the period 1930-1933, when Hitler had testified to the legality of party operations.
17. Did you send a telegram to the five SA men condemned to death in Beuthen, Upper Silesia, for violation of the Emergency Decree on 28 Aug/32? What was the content of this telegram? Did the party consider these men to actually have been engaging in legal political activity?
18. Was the party aware of the activity of its branch in Hesse in August and September of 1932? What knowledge did you have of Werner Best's preparation of the Boxheimer Dokumente before it was publicized in the press? Was the activity of these men in conformance with party policy at the time? On what grounds did you reaffirm in November of 1932, after the publication of the Boxheimer Dokumente, the legality of party operation? Were you ordered to by Hitler?
19. What contact did the Reichsleitung of the party maintain with the state government of Thuringen after Dr. Frick became Minister of Interior in that state? Was a deliberate attempt made to introduce party propaganda into Thuringen schools?
20. What was the provocation for the large scale anti-Semitic outbreak against the Jews in Berlin in the middle of September, 1931? What part did the party leadership play in initiating these outbreaks? What part did the SA leadership play?
